What We Do

The Transportation Program of REAL Services provides rides to ambulatory persons 60 years of age and older, who no longer have the ability to drive themselves. Rides are provided to places such as:

- Doctor Offices
- Grocery Stores
- Hair Dressers
- Therapy Sessions
- Banks
- Other necessary appointments

Whether you need permanent or temporary assistance, the Transportation Program is here to help.

(We can also provide grocery shoppers for home-bound clients.)

Availability

Rides are provided on a reservation basis and must be made in advance. Transportation is provided in specific areas of St. Joseph County.

Cost

Clients may pay privately (\$40.00 round trip) or if eligible, may receive financial assistance through Title III or other funding sources. Donations are requested for those qualifying for Title III funds. An application is required before Transportation Services begin.
